ORDER SETTING HEARING AND NOTICE OF HEARING

TO THE PARTIES IN THIS MATTER:

A. Jurisdiction

1. United Power, Inc. is a member-owned not-for-profit distribution electric cooperative that has exempted itself from Colorado Public Utilities Commission (PUC) regulation under Articles 1-7 of Title 40, C.R.S. See §§ 40-9.5-103 and -104, C.R.S. Because United Power has exempted itself from the PUC's jurisdiction for purposes of Article 6 of Title 40, (Hearings and Investigations), Ms. Iwaskow and Ms. Weeber (herein, COMPLAINANTS) brought to the United Power Board of Directors (Board) their concerns regarding the Board's June 24, 2026 decision to cancel the Non-Standard Meter ("NSM") Tariff.

2. The Board's Rules and Regulations of United Power (herein, "Regulations") are publicly available on its website. These Regulations are promulgated in the best interests of United Power and its Members, and are also established in accordance with the provisions of § 40-9.5-109, C.R.S. which provides in pertinent part, as follows:

"The board of directors of each cooperative electric association shall adopt regulations which specify a procedure for Members and consumers to register complaints about and be given an opportunity to be heard by the board on the rates changed by such association, the manner in which the electric service is provided, and proposed changes in the rates or regulations."

3. Ms. Iwaskow submitted a complaint via e-mail on September 16, 2026, and Ms. Weeber provided an email and attached letter to the Board on September 21, 2026. Staff determined to treat each submission as a formal complaint to be heard by the Board.

4. Per Section XV.G.5. of United Power's Regulations, these two complaints will be consolidated to one proceeding because the issues are substantially similar and the rights of the parties will not be prejudiced by such consolidation.

5. Ms. Iwaskow conveyed to staff that she would like to speak to the Board. United Power staff provided information for Ms. Iwaskow to participate at the publicly noticed September 23, 2026 Board Meeting. See United Power, Board Meeting Information (available at www.unitedpower.com/board-meetings-minutes (last viewed Sept. 23, 2026)). Ms. Iwaskow did not respond to staff's instructions to participate.

6. The Board meeting was held at United Power Headquarters, 500 Cooperative Way, Brighton, Colorado, as scheduled on the publicly noticed Agenda, and Ms. Iwaskow did not attend.

7. Per Section XV.G.1. of United Power's Regulations, a response to a submission deemed a formal complaint may be filed by United Power's staff within ten days following the filing of the formal complaint. Given the additional submission filed on September 21, 2026, this Order extends the deadline for Staff's response from September 28, 2026, to October 2, 2026.

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8. The Hearing shall be conducted in accordance with Section XV.G.6 of the Regulations.

B. Hearing Notice

United Power, Inc. orders that a hearing in this matter is set before the Board on:

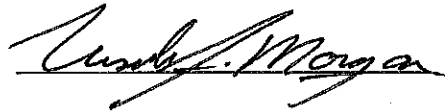
