

2026 SMALL COMMERCIAL RATES

Effective Jan. 1, 2026

SMALL COMMERCIAL (<100 KW) (C1)

The standard Small Commercial energy rate. Applicable for all commercial uses where total load does not exceed one hundred (100) kilowatts for all commercial uses.

Energy (per kWh)	\$0.1316
Demand (per kW) <i>Highest anytime demand</i>	\$4.60
Fixed Charge	\$23.00

Standard Rate Hours

ENERGY

Flat energy rate 24 hours per day.

DEMAND

Highest 15-minute interval reached *ANYTIME* of day.
Billed at the single highest interval over the billing cycle.



SMALL COMMERCIAL TIME OF USE (<100KW) (CTD1)

The Small Commercial Time of Use rate offers a reduced off-peak energy charge to shift energy away from on-peak hours. Includes anytime demand (kW) charge. Applicable for all commercial uses where total load does not exceed one hundred (100) kilowatts for all commercial uses.

On-Peak Energy (per kWh)	\$0.2249
Off-Peak Energy (per kWh)	\$0.0663
Demand (per kW) <i>Highest anytime demand</i>	\$5.25
Fixed Charge	\$30.00

Time of Use Hours

ON-PEAK ENERGY

5 p.m. – 9 p.m., Monday – Saturday

OFF-PEAK ENERGY

9 p.m. – 5 p.m., Monday – Saturday, all day Sunday, and major holidays*.

DEMAND

Demand does NOT take a day off. Demand billed at highest 15-minute interval *ANYTIME* during the day and can occur during on-peak or off-peak periods on any day of the week (including holidays).
